Our organization is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit as designated by the U.S. Internal Revenue Serivce and is incorporated as such in the state of Delaware.

 Describe your Organisation's structure (e.g. governing and decisionmaking bodies and processes):

Our organization is led by an executive director with the support of five staff and under the direction of a 15-member board of directors consisting of 13 elected members and two appointed. Dues-paying members of the association are able to participate in the election. Board members serve two-year terms, with half of the members elected in alternating years. Board members lead and serve on various

committees to help guide the organization and execute strategy. The committee most likely to participate in ICANN deliberations is our legal affairs committee, which includes several board members, ONA's legal counsel, and a legal scholar.

We have roughly 2,300 dues-paying members, primarily consisting of working journalists, journalism instructors and journalism students, technologists, plus a small number of members affiliated with journalism, but not practicing journalism professionally.

e. Describe how your Organisation keeps its constituents/membership informed about, and enables them to participate in, decisions regarding issues of interest:

Our members are informed about ONA activities through in-person local meet-ups, weekly newsletters, regular website blog posts and site updates, social media engagement and our annual conference. The community is multi-directional, as we both announce activities, programs and other undertakings, as well as seeking input, guidance and feedback from members on issues. For example, we are currently working on a Code of Ethics guide through a crowdsourcing initiative. Likewise, our conference is built by soliciting session suggestions. Finally, we create opportunities for in-person dialog at our local meetups, the annual conference, and other venues for members to participate in issues of interest.

We have 1,708 in the professional class, 245 students, 283 journalism instructors, and 105 associate members.
