Knujon accepts junk email from the public and returns reports and policy enforcement action. Cumulative results are used to troubleshoot the general Internet policy structure for the benefit of all involved. We believe that the Internet bureaucracy is too complex to expect ordinary consumers and small businesses to navigate it alone. Our tools are the engines and workflows we have developed that allow anyone, anywhere to report abuse without needing to understand the technology, policy or underlying infrastructure. Our intent is to advocate for the Internet user whether they be individual or entity.

Beyond this advocacy, we believe our process is a profound contribution to the existing policy structure, augmenting current procedures and pinpointing failures. The overall goal being to streamline the Internet's policy enforcement structure and enhance the stability of the global network.
